

OUR FUNDING INITIATIVES

If you're invited to apply for support from Global's Make Some Noise, you'll need to submit a plan for a designated programme, service or project that we can fund.

This could be a project you're already delivering, a development to an existing service or a completely new initiative. Remember, all projects need to provide direct support to children, young people and their families.

To help you pick the right project for funding, check out the list below of the areas we can and can't fund.

What we can fund

Revenue projects including:

- ✓ Roles
- ✓ Care provision & support
- ✓ Therapy
- ✓ Counselling
- ✓ Nursing
- ✓ Play work
- ✓ Respite
- ✓ Other support sessions/activities

Capital projects* including:

- ✓ Equipping an activity room (e.g. sensory room equipment)
- ✓ Refurbishing an activity room (e.g. a playroom)
- ✓ Purchasing large equipment



*If you're creating, equipping or furnishing spaces, you'll need to either own or have agreed a lease of at least 10 years on the building or area you're requesting funds for. You'll also need to demonstrate how you will be able to maintain the space or equipment beyond the life of a Global's Make Some Noise grant.

What we can't fund

- ✗ Activities that do not directly contribute to the welfare or development of children, young people and their families affected by illness, disability or lack of opportunity.
- ✗ Local government or NHS bodies.
- ✗ Projects which promote religion, politics or other activity that is not for wider public benefit.
- ✗ Trips or projects abroad.
- ✗ Corporate or business activity.
- ✗ Grants to individuals.
- ✗ Other grant-makers or projects where funds are to be redirected to other organisations or individuals.
- ✗ Projects where the grant expenditure is due to start before the grant award date (retrospective funding).
