

KEEP IT LEGAL

We like to make sure you're safe and legal when fundraising, so don't forget to follow our golden fundraising rules...

- 1 Be clear about who you're raising money for and always use our full name 'Global's Make Some Noise'
- 2 Be clear about how much of the amount raised is going to Global's Make Some Noise. For example, 100% or 50%.
- 3 If you create any materials of your own make sure it has the following line of text on it:
Global's Make Some Noise is an appeal operated by Global Charities, a registered charity in England and Wales (1091657) & Scotland (SC041475)
- 4 If you're collecting money in a public place, make sure you have written permission to be there from your local council.
- 5 Once you've collected your money, follow our guide to pay it in safely and quickly. For more specific rules, visit the fundraising regulator's website.
